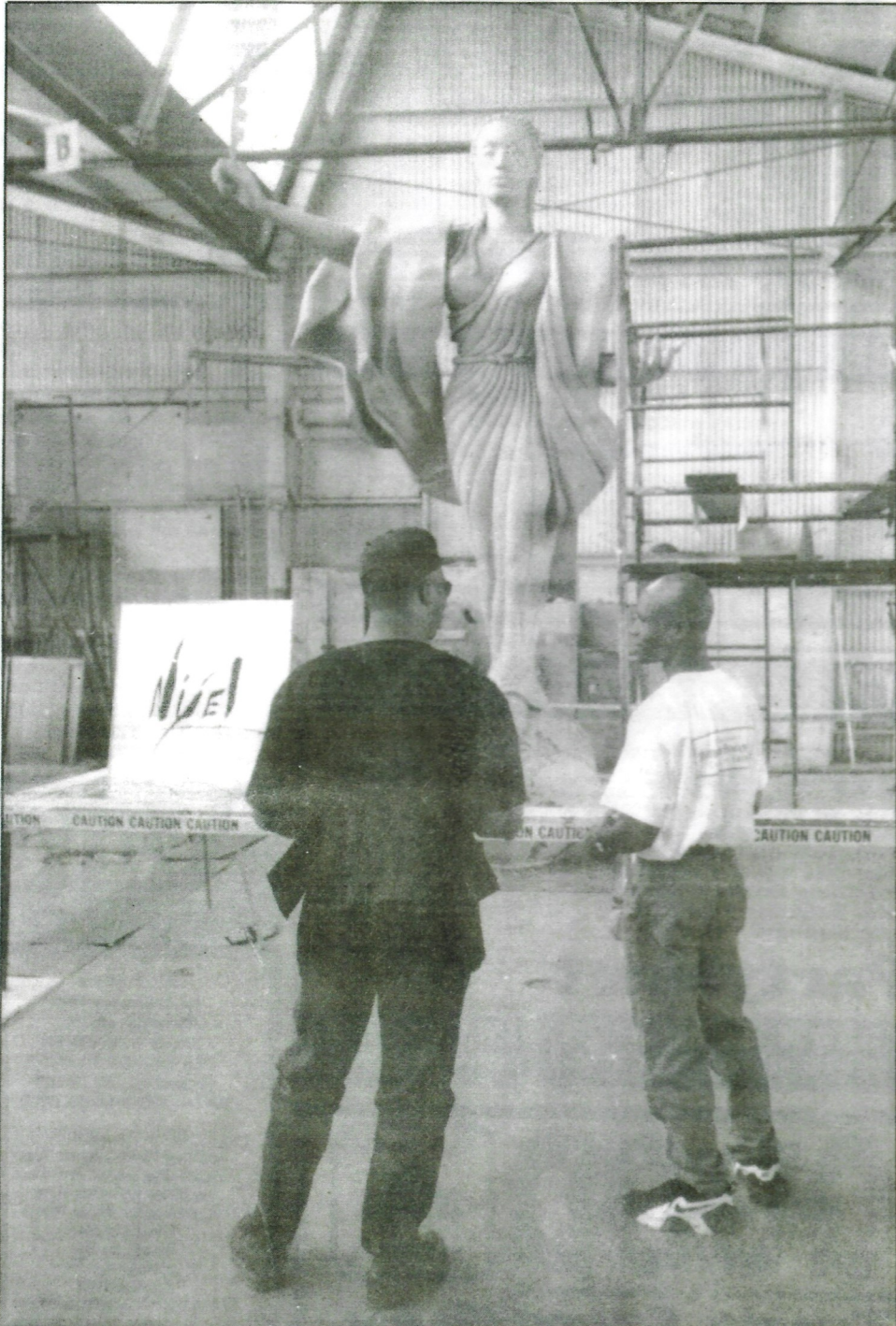


Landmark Lady
